



WHAT IS THE LEAVING CERTIFICATE APPLIED PROGRAMME

- It is a distinct, self-contained two-year Leaving Certificate programme aimed at preparing students for adult and working life
- It highlights forms of achievement and excellence which the established Leaving Certificate does not recognise.

LCA: WHAT SORT OF STUDENTS SHOULD APPLY?

- Students who would normally take all ordinary level subjects at Leaving Cert. aspiring to a grade 06/07.
- Kinaesthetic Learners Students who find difficulty with learning "by rote" rather than learning by doing.
- > Students who have difficulty with essay type answers.



WHO WOULD BENEFIT FROM LEAVING CERTIFICATE APPLIED?

- Students who are not adequately catered for by the traditional Leaving Certificate programme
- It offers the opportunity to prepare for and progress to further education and training, PLCs & Solas (FÁS)
- Students wishing to progress to Universities or Institutes of Technology must first of all do a 1-year PLC course pafter the LCA programme

WHAT IS THE RATIONALE OF THE LEAVING CERTIFICATE APPLIED PROGRAMME

- Prepares students for adult and working life
- ✓ Key component of LCA is work experience
- ✓ Work experience takes place ne day a week
- ✓ Students will have <u>four</u> different work experience
 - placements over the two years

WHAT IS THE RATIONALE OF THE LEAVING CERTIFICATE APPLIED PROGRAMME (CONT.)


- ✓ Applies knowledge and skills to the solution of real problems
